7. (2) Name the 3 leaders at the head of the Meccan army.
8. (2) Before the battle, what message does Abu Sufyan send to the Ansar?
9. (2) Who is Abd Amr bin Saifi?
  
10. (2) How do the Meccan women participate in the battle?
11. (2) At the beginning of the battle, what are the Quraish trying to protect?
12. (1) Which tribe is mainly responsible for protecting this item?
  
13. (1) As the Muslims appear to be winning the battle, how many archers leave their position?

15. (1) How many archers remain at their post – as the Prophet (S) had ordered?
