EXTRA CREDIT (25 points): Dig a Trench: Just before the Battle of the Trench, several hundred Sahabah dug a ditch across the northern part of Medina to protect it. In just 1 week, they moved thousands of pounds of earth to create the trench that was over 1 mile long, about 8-10 feet deep and 12 feet across.

To get a little idea of how this could have felt, dig a small ‘trench’ in your backyard with the dimensions: **2 ft long x 1 ft wide x 1 ft deep**.
