Read **pp. 511-512, 538-546** in “Nectar” and answer the following **neatly** on a separate sheet of paper(s).

Hajj of Abu Bakr (R)

1. (5) Regarding the Hajj of Abu Bakr (R): (Circle all that are true.)
 - a. Allah sends instructions in Surah Al-Jamrah
 - b. Called ‘Hajj of Abu Bakr’ but Abu Bakr (R) gets ill and cannot make it.
 - c. Occurs in 9 AH.
